A message from our CEO



Last year, Bondi became a place of profound heartbreak for our community. Fifteen innocent lives were taken in a brutal act of terror, leaving a heavy grief and reminding us of life's fragility and the significance of our **shared responsibility** for our Jewish community.

They say that when a child is born, a new light appears in the world.* By the close of 2025, amidst the weight of our collective grief, AJFN had helped bring **27 new lights** into the world - **27 dreams fulfilled, 27 universes created and 27 new contributors** to Jewish life in Australia.

And yet, even as we celebrate these precious beginnings, **150 families** are still waiting, carrying silent grief, navigating years of uncertainty and enduring fertility journeys that are often far longer and harder than anyone can imagine. This is why AJFN exists: to ensure that **no Jewish Australian ever walks a fertility journey alone**.

In 2025, we celebrated not only 27 new lights but also **completed our national expansion** so that access to support would never depend on postcode. We strengthened our on-the-ground presence, **trained more Peer Support Companions**, and expanded our reach across every sector of the Jewish community. At the same time, we worked tirelessly to **raise the funds** needed to meet growing demand.

What we have learned, unequivocally, is that while **financial support can offer moments of hope, ongoing emotional support sustains families over time**. Fertility journeys are rarely linear. They stretch across months and years, filled with hope, disappointment, resilience and grief. Walking alongside families through every stage **is not optional. It is essential**.

In the wake of so much loss, we are reminded that AJFN's work is ultimately about **continuity, choosing life, compassion and responsibility** even in the face of heartbreak.

Your partnership ensures that **the light continues to shine**, for those welcoming new life today and for those still waiting, praying and hoping for their miracle tomorrow.

Why is AJFN needed?

Jewish communal life centres on children and family. For those facing infertility, this can make an already painful journey feel even more isolating.

Due to the prevalence of certain inherited genetic conditions, members of the Jewish community are more likely to require genetic screening and, in some cases, assisted reproductive technologies (ART) on their pathway to parenthood.

One IVF cycle in Australia can cost up to \$12,000. Medicare covers roughly half of this, leaving families to pay the remainder, plus the costs of medications, donor services and repeat cycles.

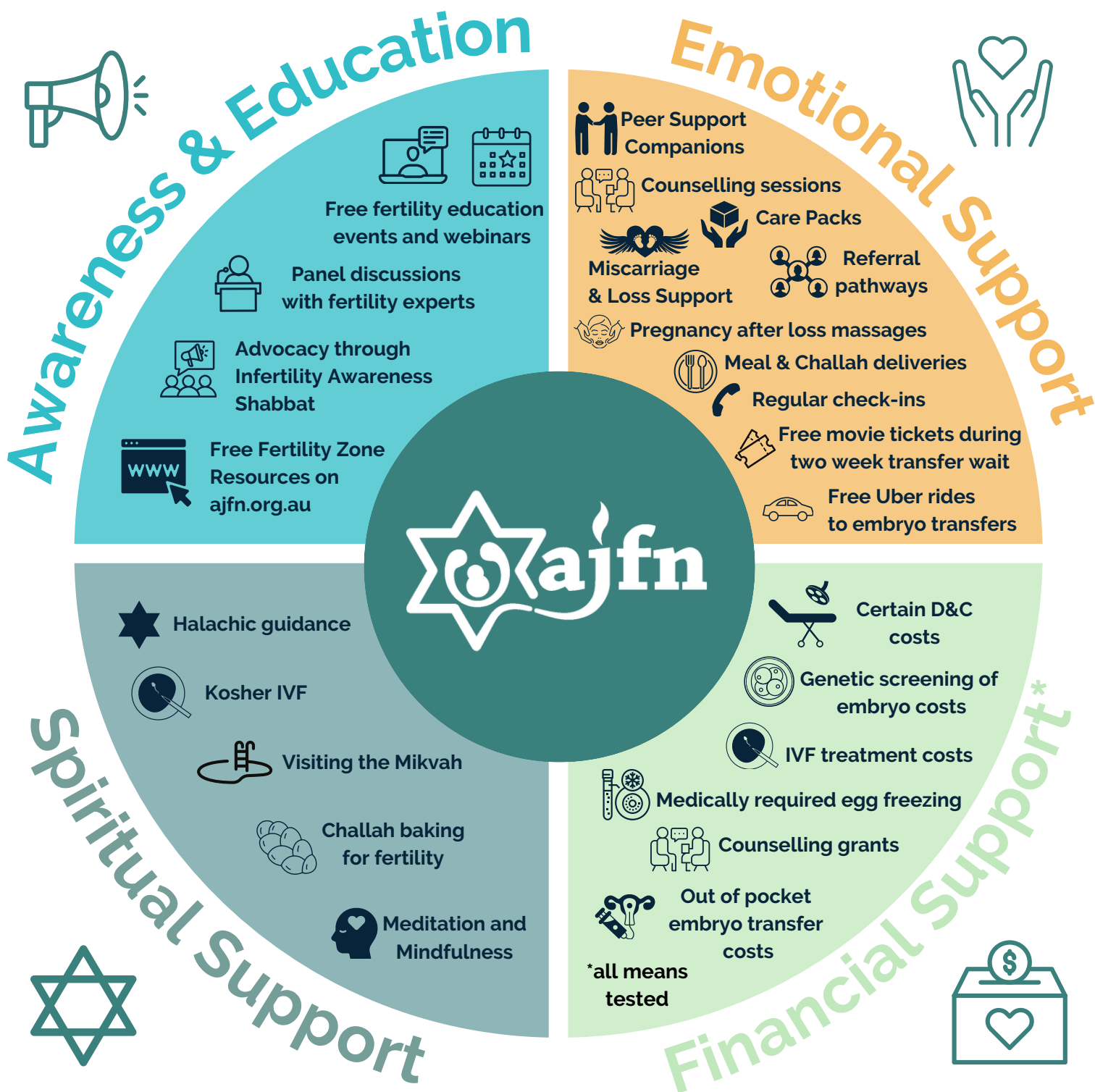
Infertility has a profound mental health impact, bringing repeated cycles of hope and heartbreak that can lead to anxiety, depression, grief, and isolation.

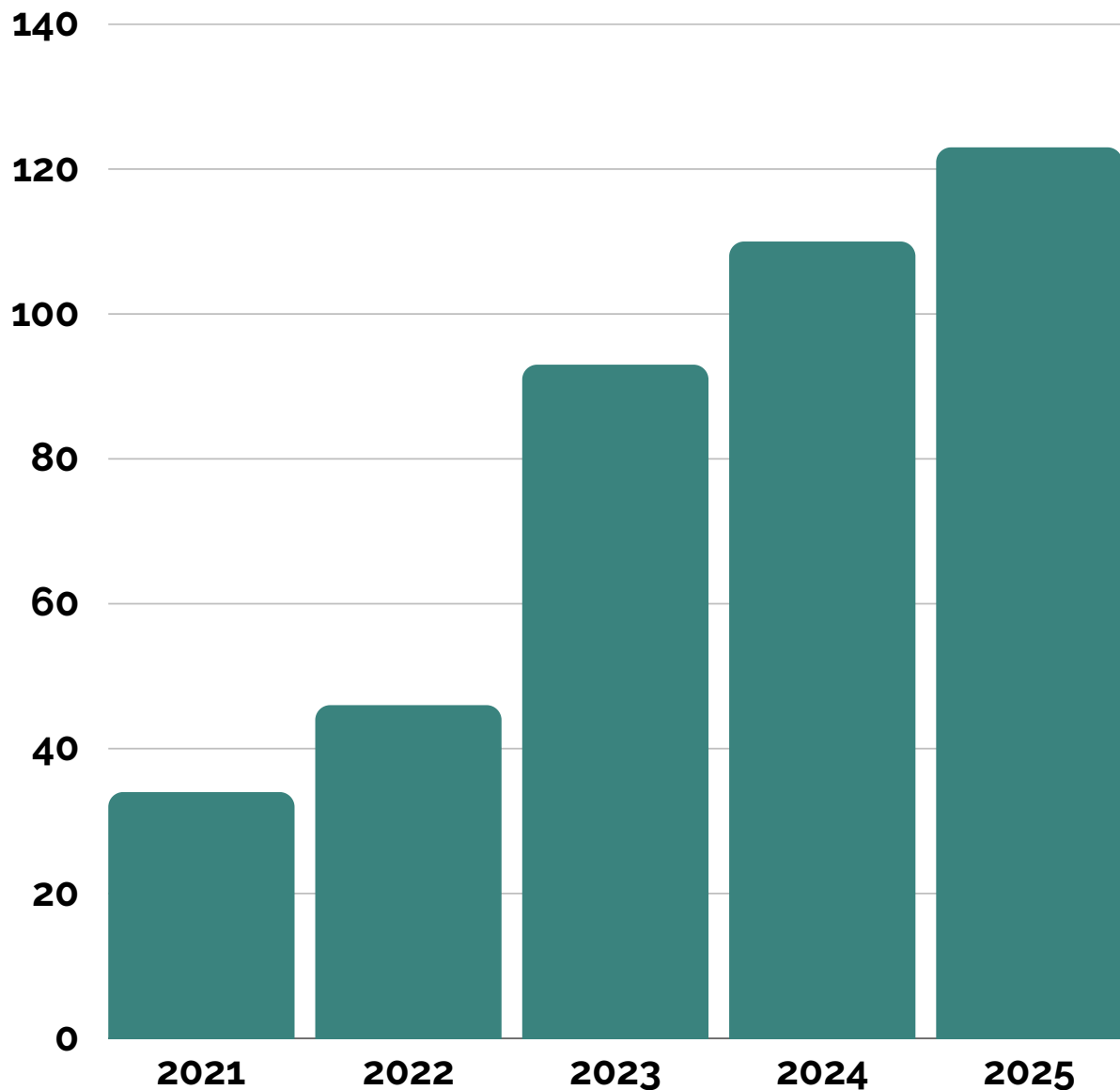

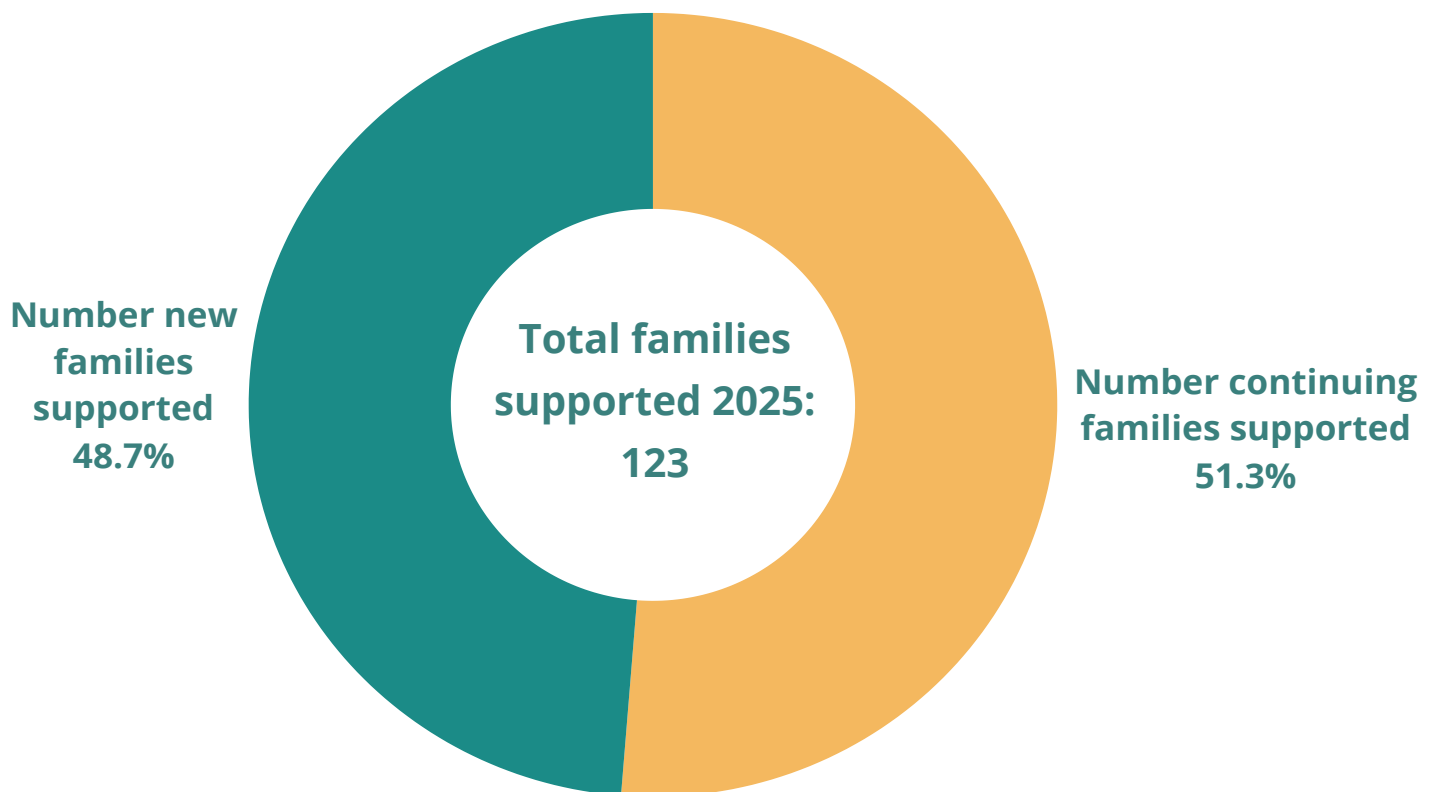

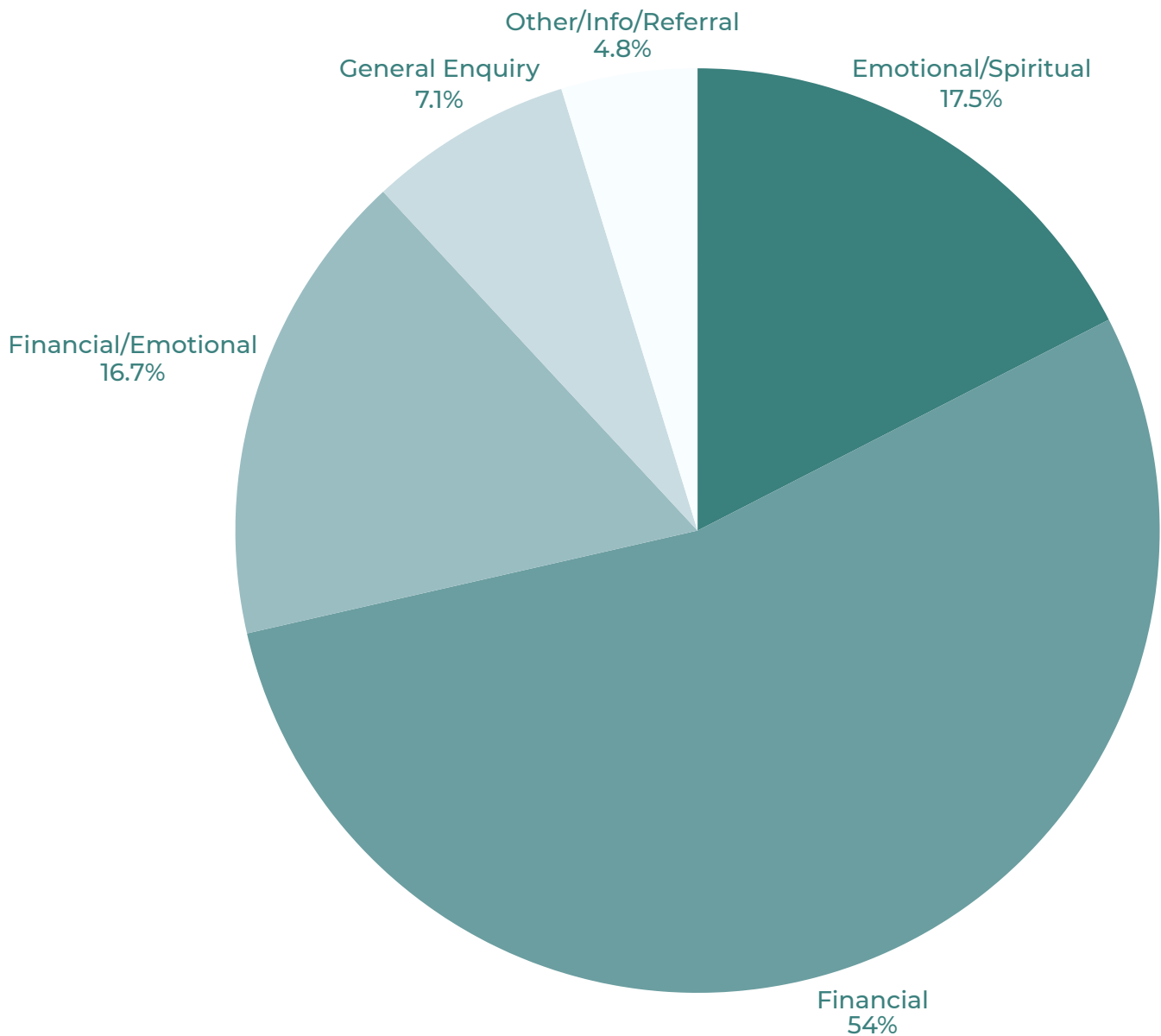
More than half of the families we supported in 2025 were continuing from 2024, demonstrating that fertility journeys are often long and complex and require sustained support over time.

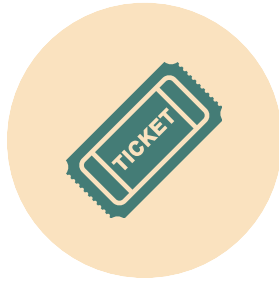
